

Role of Disability Services

Disability Services will help you get the accommodations you need for equal access to college. If you are an otherwise qualified and an admitted CLC student, this is one of your civil rights:

The Disability Coordinator....

- Meets with students to determine appropriate and reasonable accommodations
- Collects and maintains disability-related documents
- Certifies the student's eligibility for services
- Informs students about obtaining reasonable accommodations
- Facilitates provision of reasonable accommodations.

The Disability Coordinator does not....

- Automatically know that you are a student with a disability.. you must inform us.
- Talk with your instructors and ask for modifications to course rigor, you must complete the same program/assignments/tests as your non-disabled peers.
- Keep track of your progress and report to your parents.
