Other Information:

- All 1 and 2 credit courses will have their final exams during the last class meeting prior to the beginning of final exams.
- All 3+ credit courses meeting one day/week will have their final exams during the last class meeting prior to the beginning of final exams.
- All 3+ credit lecture/lab courses that have labs scheduled separately from the lecture will have their final exams when the lecture meets according to the above schedule.
- If no regular class date falls during finals, the test will be given the last possible day prior to the beginning of final exams.

Evening classes:

- 3+ credit courses with beginning times between 4:00 and 6:29 PM will have the final exam on the first possible regular night during finals week. The test will begin at the regular starting time and run for 1.5 hours. Instructors may, at their discretion, schedule the final exam to begin ½ hour early if they need the full 2 hours.
- 3+ credit courses with beginning times at 6:30 PM or later will have the final exam on the first possible regular night during finals week. In either case the test will begin at the regular starting time and run for two hours.
- ***If there are any conflicts in the scheduling of final exams you must contact the Vice President of Academic & Student Affairs before rescheduling the final exam.***

Other Information:

- All 1 and 2 credit courses will have their final exams during the last class meeting prior to the beginning of final exams.
- All 3+ credit courses meeting one day/week will have their final exams during the last class meeting prior to the beginning of final exams.
- All 3+ credit lecture/lab courses that have labs scheduled separately from the lecture will have their final exams when the lecture meets according to the above schedule.
- If no regular class date falls during finals, the test will be given the last possible day prior to the beginning of final exams.

Evening classes:

- 3+ credit courses with beginning times between 4:00 and 6:29 PM will have the final exam on the first possible regular night during finals week. The test will begin at the regular starting time and run for 1.5 hours. Instructors may, at their discretion, schedule the final exam to begin ½ hour early if they need the full 2 hours.
- 3+ credit courses with beginning times at 6:30 PM or later will have the final exam on the first possible regular night during finals week. In either case the test will begin at the regular starting time and run for two hours.
