**NOTES:** The student must earn a "C" or above in nursing courses and required liberal arts and science courses.

A student earning a grade below a C cannot progress or graduate.

Students will need to meet the required general education requirement of 30 credits.

*In order to receive a degree, diploma, or certificate from Central Lakes College, students must complete one-third of their credits at Central Lakes College. For programs exceeding 60 credits, a maximum of 20 semester credits must be completed at Central Lakes College.*

Human Biology I and II will be accepted as prerequisite courses instead of Anatomy and Physiology I and II **IF** the Human Biology sequence was begun prior to Fall 2007. Human Biology II will be offered in Summer 2007 and for the **last time** in Spring of 2008. Students who take Human Biology I and II as prerequisite courses for the (AD) Nursing program must meet the required general education requirements of 30 credits with a minimum of 64 credits required for graduation."
