B.S. Degree in Nursing **Bemidji State University** (RN to Baccalaureate Track)

A. REQUIREMENTS:

1. The BS Degree in Nursing program is specifically designed to admit **only** registered nurse graduate of diploma and associate degree programs.
2. Completion of the Associate in Science (AS) Degree in Nursing from CLC satisfies the requirements at the above listed college.
3. Completion of the Associate in Arts (AA) is **not** required at the college above prior to starting this program. However, you must complete the general education requirements prior to completion of this program. Both the MnTC and AA Degree will satisfy this requirement.

B. GRADE POINT AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS:

C. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Submit application for admission, official post-secondary transcripts and application fee. Minimum GPA of 2.0. If you have earned less than 24 credits, you will need to request an official high school transcript as well.
