



Nursing - Associate in Science Degree Advanced Standing Program Admission and Progression Requirements

ADMISSION:

Application Submission Priority Deadline: November 1st for a for a Spring Semester start in the transition course
July 1st for a Fall Semester start in the transition course

*Entrance into the program and core Nursing classes would be started the semester after successful completion of the Transitions course (note courses are not offered summer session)

Admission requirements/ranking: TEAS Test Score at or above 70
Completion of a Practical Nursing Program

It is required that all students in the AD Advanced Standing Program at CLC are LPN's in Minnesota by August 1st for fall entry to the program, and by the 1st of January for spring entry into the program, as it is an "Advanced Standing" program (an Advanced Standing Program requires that all students demonstrate proof of a current unrestricted LPN license in the State of Minnesota). The transitions course may be taken before the candidate has an LPN license, but candidate will not be allowed to progress further without a license.

As well as meeting all of the following requirements:

General Education – Minimum grade of “C” in the following courses PLUS a Cumulative GPA of 3.0 for the following courses:

- CHEM 1407 Life Science Chemistry – pre-requisite*
- PSYC 2421 General Psychology – pre-requisite*
- BIOL 2467 Anatomy & Physiology I – pre-requisite*
- ENGL 1411 Composition II – pre-requisite*

General Education – Must achieve a “C” or higher in the following courses:

- ENGL 1410 Composition I – pre-requisite*
- PHIL 2422 Medical Ethics – pre-requisite*
- BIOL 2468 Anatomy & Physiology II – concurrent/can be completed while in the program
- BIOL 2457 Microbiology – concurrent/can be completed while in the program

Nursing Pre-Requisite Course (taken after acceptance into the program – for a Fall start, taken in Spring Semester; for a Spring start, taken in Fall Semester) – Must achieve 80% (B-) or higher to progress

- NURS 1547 Professional Nursing Role Transition

Core Nursing Courses – Must achieve 80% (B-) or higher in each course to progress

- NURS 2540 Professional Nursing Concepts II
- NURS 2541 Professional Nursing Practicum II
- NURS 2542 Advanced Skills for the Professional Nurse
- NURS 2545 Professional Nursing Concepts III
- NURS 2546 Professional Nursing Practicum III
- NURS 2547 Professional Nursing Leadership

*Pre-requisites must **ALL** be completed **before** or **during** the semester a student takes NURS 1547
