FINANCIAL AID

Financial Aid is intended to help students and their families pay for educational costs. Eighty percent of CLC Financial Aid applicants receive some type of financial assistance.

FINANCIAL AID STEPS:

1. Create FSA ID at studentaid.gov.
Every dependent student & parent must have their own FSA ID.
2. Complete the FAFSA at studentaid.gov, use CLC's code = **002339**.
Once submitted, it takes 5-7 business days before CLC receives your FAFSA results.
3. The Dept. of Education will email a **Student Aid Report (SAR)** for your review.
If you find an error, contact the CLC Financial Aid Office.
4. CLC will email you to verify that your file is complete OR to request additional information. **READ thoroughly and return ALL requested information as soon as possible to keep your application from being delayed.**
5. The Award Notification shows eligible amounts for grants, loans, and workstudy based on credits per semester.
6. To borrow loan money, **YOU MUST** complete the loan application steps in **E-Services**.

Use 2022 filed taxes for 2024-25 FAFSA (Fall 2024 - Summer 2025)

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID



Grants - This money usually doesn't need to be repaid



Loans - Funding you must repay along with interest.

Subsidized - Government pays the interest while you are in school

Unsubsidized - Interest is accruing while you are in school

Alternative - Loans from an outside lender



Work-study - Jobs both on and off campus



Scholarships - Students are responsible to apply for CLC Foundation and outside scholarships

What is needed to be considered for a scholarship?

Be currently accepted into a CLC Program of Study as an undergraduate student

- Register for a minimum of 6 credits at Central Lakes College
- Recommend (not required) to complete the FAFSA
- Submit general scholarship application each semester (fall and spring)
- PSEO students are not eligible to apply

If selected to receive a scholarship, when will I receive the funds?

Scholarship payments are applied to your bill on the Financial Aid Disbursement date.

How to apply for External Scholarships?

Many high schools, professional associations and service organizations offer scholarships. Contact that organization for application information.



On average, nearly half of the students who apply for CLC Foundation scholarships are awarded a scholarship.

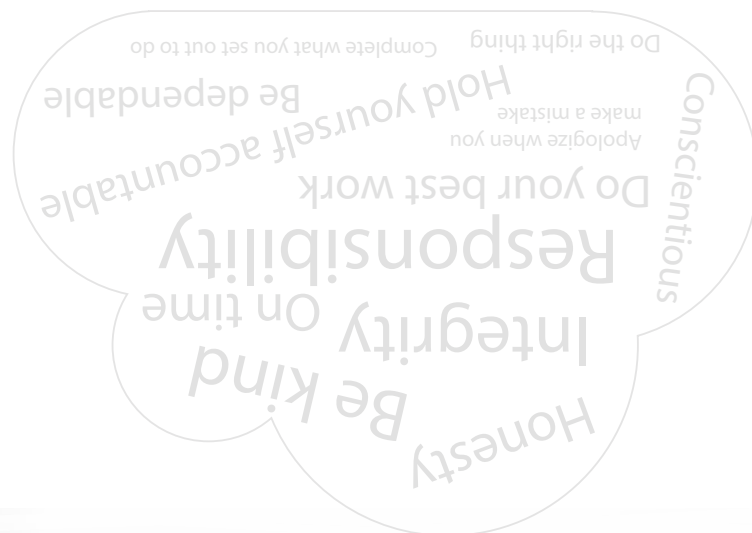

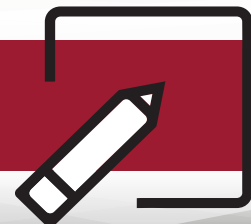

POLICIES

Academic Honors:

Must be registered for 12+ semester credits with no incomplete courses ("I" grade). **PRESIDENT'S LIST: 3.75-4.0**

DEAN'S LIST: 3.25-3.74

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP):

Maintain both a 6 credit cumulative GPA of 2.0 AND a cumulative completion rate of 66.67% of all credits registered for, including all transfer credits.

Free Add/Drop:

For most courses, you have the first five days of the semester to add and/or drop one or all of the courses. Dates are specific to each course and listed in E-Services.

Withdraw:

After Free Add/Drop, see an advisor if you want to withdraw from a course(s) as there could be academic and/or financial aid implications.

Failure for Non-Attendance (FN) or Unofficial Withdraw (FW) Policy:

FN = Instructors reported you did not attend class, participate and/or complete an assignment during days 1-5. You will not receive financial aid for FN course(s) and you may have to pay the tuition & fees.

FW = If you stop attending, instructors will enter an FW grade. You may have to repay the financial aid dollars received for the FW course(s).

DROP FOR NONPAYMENT

To avoid having your courses dropped, CLC MUST have one of the following:

- Notice in our Financial Aid Office from the federal government that you have applied for FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), **OR**
- Payment of \$300.00 or 15% minimum down on tuition and fees, **OR**
- A payment plan contract in place with Nelnet (additional information available at Nelnet Payment Plan, **OR**
- A 3rd Party authorization (CEP, DRS, Vets, PSEO, etc.) on file with the CLC Business Office.
